Fairfax, VA — A virtually invisible application technique has been developed by Washington, DC based TECVAC, Inc. for the application of graffiti coating to concrete, masonry and stone surfaces. The requirements of VDOT were straight forward; give us graffiti protection and don't change the color of the concrete. After pre-testing a number of different methods, a method/product combination resulted in an application that was very nearly invisible. When the first phase of the application was completed, a slight darkening of the surface, a wet appearance, was evident. Overnight, the evidence disappeared however and side by side comparison of treated/untreated concrete panels were indistinguishable. Removal of spray paint was a snap with a low pressure power washer. The long fly over abutment wall was completed and now stands protected. As a testament to the transparency of the application, when the project was completed, a VDOT inspector noted on the punch list that it did not look like the anti-graffiti coating had been applied to the abutment walls as required!
