Washington, DC — TECVAC, Inc. has joined the investigative team of Bryant Bryant Williams, P.C./Oudens+Koop Architects, P.C. to investigate and support resolution efforts now being conducted at Washington's historic Union Station. Leaking expansion joints located in the link structure, connecting the station with the parking garage, have been a chronic problem for Amtrak's 24 hour operations.

Thermal expansions and contractions are great and the joints endure a heavy burden of traffic. Daily in and out travel of tour buses, commuters and taxis pound the joints relentlessly. This around-the-clock passage quickly wreaks havoc on repairs and has been a source of real frustration.

TECVAC technicians applied their investigative skills and have successfully identified and temporarily repaired a number of areas of intrusion. To the pleasure of Amtrak, TECVAC has quickly stifled the unwieldy amount of overhead water leakage to a manageable trickle. The investigation is scheduled to conclude in September '98 when TECVAC, Inc. will implement repairs. ##
